### Directions to Middlesex County 4-H Fairgrounds, Westford, MA (Route 110):

**From Gardner Area:** 2E to 495N to Exit 32 Westford/Boston Road (to Route 225). Off exit, take right. At lights, turn left. After market Basket (on right), take right on South Chelmsford Road. Fairgrounds are 1 mile on right.

**From Boston Area:** 495S to Exit 32. Take left off exit. See above.

**From Springfield Area:** Take Mass Pike to Exit 11A (I-495) towards NH/Maine/Cape Cod. Keep left at fork in ramp and merge into 495N. Follow to Exit 32 Westford/Boston Road (to Route 225). Off exit, take right. At lights, turn left. After market Basket (on right), take tight on South Chelmsford Road. Fairgrounds are 1 mile on right.

*Standing stalls are available first-come-first-serve basis.*



## Class/Division Eligibility

If you are a **LEADLINE RIDER**, you are eligible for: Leadline Division.  
**RIDER MAY NOT ENTER ANY OTHER DIVISION.**

If you are a **WALK-TROT RIDER**, you are eligible for *Walk-Trot Division only. You may Jump in Class 24 - X-Rails - ONLY.*

If you are in the **OPEN BEGINNER WALK/TROT/CANTER/LOPE DIVISION**, you are eligible for *Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter/Lope and Gymkhana divisions. You may jump in Class 25 ONLY.*

If you are a **WALK/TROT/CANTER/LOPE RIDER**, you are eligible for the Junior or Senior Division, You may jump in Class 26 (Jr) or 27 (Sr), and the Open Equitation over 2'6" Fences. End of Day points (for championship) the BEST placing in the jumping class(es) entered. **Year-End Points for those in the 4-H Horse Show Series, may ONLY receive points for Class 26 or 27.**

**4-H DIVISION** - is open to all 4-H Members and their registered  
**4-H Projects (must be registered as of 6/27/08)**

## Rules and Regulations

- Riders must wear hard-soled boots with a heel and an ASTM/SEI Approved Hard Hat as marked on the inside of the hat with a built-in safety harness securely fastened at all times when mounted.
- Proper show attire required, except in games.
- Massachusetts State laws require proof of Negative Coggins test and shot records (rabies, EWT) with horse's name and description on all paperwork.
- Judge's decision final; classes may be changed at the judge's discretion. No one shall approach judges for any reason until the end of the show.
- Horses must be in complete control before leaving the ring; horses must remain at a walk outside the ring unless in the designated warm-up area.
- Descriptions of gymkhana classes will be explained prior to the start of each class.
- Water and concessions will be available on the show grounds.
- The show manager reserves the right to decline any entry, cancel, combine, divide or vary classes as deemed necessary.
- All horses that kick must wear a red ribbon on their tail.
- Riding, lunging and grazing horses on the main infield (grassy area) is prohibited.
- For the safety of our riders please refrain from sitting or leaning on the ring. Sitting permitted in designated areas only.
- This Horse Show is part of the Middlesex Horse Advisory Council Series. Points Awarded & Tracked for all 4-H Members and their registered projects. There will be an end of the series awards banquet.
